Abstract submission

Outline abstract submission shall be done via the IWA online submission system: [CLICK HERE TO SUBMIT YOUR PAPER](#).

Please, fill in the form following the instructions for each new submission. To ensure that your paper has been successfully submitted, you must click on the “send” button at the end of the process.

In case you need to modify your submission, send an email to academiciwa@ucm.edu.co.

Topics: Confirm that subjects (see above) fit your research.

File naming: File names will have to include the family name of the first author (e.g. Suarez.doc).

Format: The outline abstract should be uploaded onto the submission system as a Word file and it must follow [the template](#). Abstracts can be written in Spanish, Portuguese or English.

Limitations: There is no limitation on the number of abstracts submitted per author; however, a maximum of two oral or three poster presentations by the same author will be accepted.

Publication: Accepted abstracts (poster and oral presentations) will be included in the online conference program and will be shared to all registered conference participants (subject to the registration of at least one of the authors for the paper).

Full paper submission

All accepted works (poster and oral presentations) Outline paper submission shall be done via [CLICK HERE TO SUBMIT YOUR PAPER](#) (coming soon)

Publication: Accepted papers will be included in the conference proceedings with ISBN and will be distributed to all registered conference participants (subject to the registration of at least one of the authors for the paper).

After the peer-review process, the highest quality papers will be selected and authors will receive an invitation to develop full manuscripts to be submitted for publication in one of the IWA journals (namely: *Water Science and Technology*; *Water Science and Technology: Water Supply*; *Journal of Water Reuse and Desalination*; or *Journal of Hydroinformatics*) and special edition of “Revista de la Facultad de Ingeniería Universidad de Antioquía” Please note that acceptance of a paper for conference presentation does not guarantee subsequent acceptance for journal publication, the final decision on journal publication lies with the journals' Editor-in-Chief.

Once the outline paper is selected for either oral or poster presentation, at least one of the authors must register for the conference (before Early Bird Registration deadline in order to be included in the conference program) and present the paper at the conference.
